



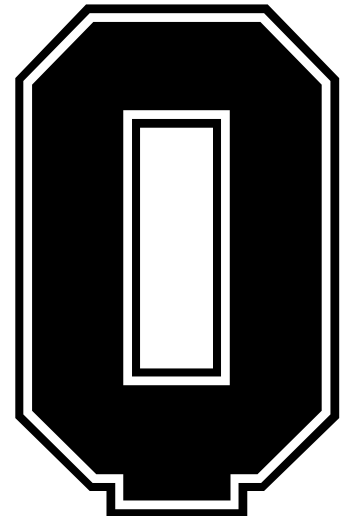
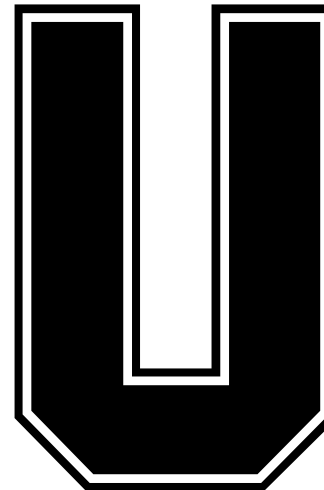
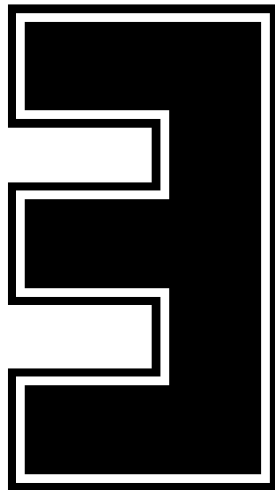
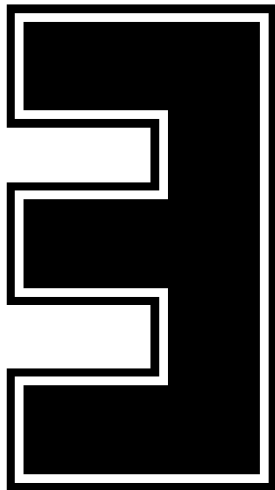
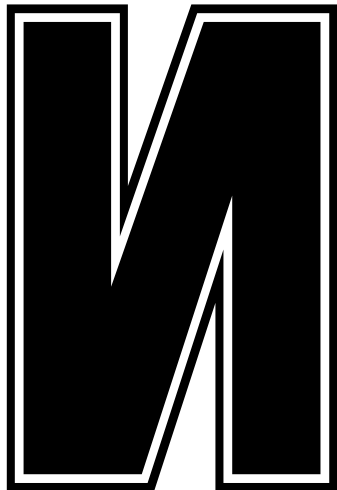
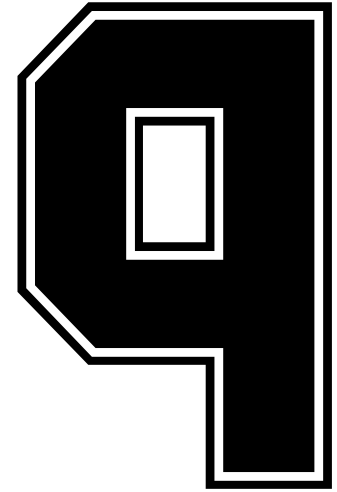
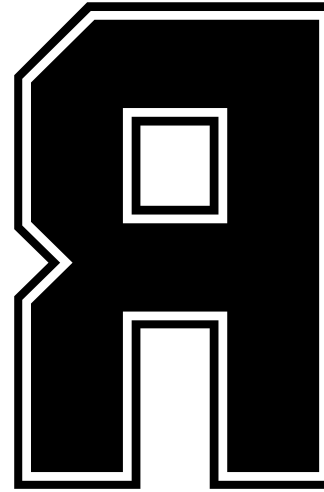
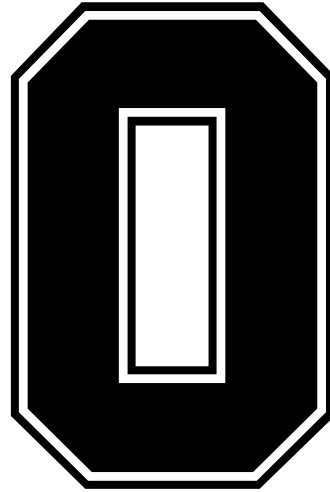
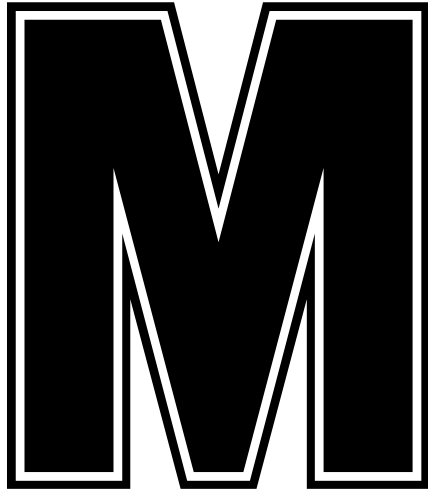
## Making Sashes

### What you will need:

- Iron-on transfer paper (found at local craft or office supply store)
- An iron
- White fabric
- White thread and needle

### How to make the sashes:

- Print out onto the iron-on transfer paper. (You will not need to reverse the image, as it is already reversed.)
- Cut out the words from the transfer paper, leaving about 1/2" trim.
- Trim out fabric so that your sash is approximately 5 inches wide.
- Iron on design to the fabric.
- Fold the sash over your shoulder and sew together the ends of the sash.

## Creating Crowns

### What you will need:

- Posterboard or Burger King crown
- Template (this page)
- Gold Spray Paint
- Decorative materials such as jewels, fur boa, etc. (Found at local craft store.)
- Hot glue

### How to make a crown:

- Trace this template onto posterboard. Repeat template until there are 5 peaks of the crown.
- Using scissors, trim out the design.
- Spray paint gold (both sides).
- Meld together the ends of the crown by using hot glue.
- Decorate by adding jewels and fur to the crown.
- \*\* You can skip the first two steps by acquiring a cardboard-crown from a local Burger King restaurant.
