Press with accusation:	Accuse.
Rise above your station:	(1) Act as if you are better than you are. (2) Advance your social status or standing.
Heed medicus warning:	Listen to your doctor.
No cause for disappointment:	Don't be let down.
Cause imposition:	Bother you. (ex: Apologies to cause imposition with the matter of)
Require favor:	Need approval.
